One of her latest ventures was organising a weekend Festival of Dance in Moama, unfortunately this has now been cancelled.

#### TOOT, TOOT, CHUF, CHUF, DINE & DANCE

At last, the long awaited evening organised by good friend Bob Bass arrived when twenty ardent dancers and friends from Melbourne met at the Belgrave Station to board the Puffing Billy for an evening of Dining and Dancing aboard this iconic train, of course some of us arrived much earlier to watch the shunting of trains and locomotives at the station until finally, our loco and train arrived.

At 7.30 we all boarded our allottad carriage to find it decorated with Christmas livery and formally set up with dining tables and seating for two or four people, there were also delightfuly presented nibblies for all and refreshments were available once we had left the station area. of course after introductions there was lots of chatter about dancing, Christmas plans and the different venues that each of us frequented. The setting was made even more delightful with the views across the Dandenong Ranges and at time across to Western Port Bay with the sun slowly disappearing between the trees on this delightful day as we travelled toward our destination stopping for a short while at Menzies Creek before being served a delightful first course of hot pumpkin soup.

After assing through Emerald, we reached our destination, Nobelius Siding, we entered the historic nursery packing shed established and owned by Carl Nobelius a migrant from Sweden arriving in Australia during 1872.











In 1892 Nobelius left his job in South Yarra and moved his family up to his Emerald property. Whilst Nobelius initially concentrated on establishing a small orchard, he soon turned his attention to nursery stock and early the following year he began trading as 'Gembrook Nurseries', as Emerald, at the time, was part of the Parish of Gembrook.

The old nursery shed was set up for eighty people, all passengers on the train with pleaseant music supplied by a sole performer and there was ample room for dancing, if that wasn't good enough there was always the station platform to be used and we made use of that later in the evening, after the rest of the meal consisting of a further two courses of a fabulous buffet main course and sweets of sticky date pudding or a choice of another delightful dessert (unknown but really nice) had been been consumed., then on with the dancing once more, unfortunately as the majority of the passengers preferred pub style music and what we call tea bag dancing the night generated into more of a disco jiggling night inside the nursery, fortunately as social and ballroom dancers we are a versatile mob and we made do with the music provided and restricted our dances to those such as the Merrilyn, Balmoral Blues, and Carousel the occasional Cha Cha and a swing or two with an odd jive or two thrown in for good measure. all out on the platform in the crisp clear air. We noticed a few envious people watching us holding each other while dancing, something they tried to replicate with little success, my alcohol does strange things to some younger people.

Around 11.00 it was time to reboard the carriage and travel back to Belgrave, all while sipping teas, coffee and port, unfortunately ,we were also forced to nibble on fine chocolates at the same time.

After disembarkeng some of us managed to find the energy to find an all night McDonalds (yes a McDonalds) where some of us enjoyed an early morning coffee and cakes, all on Seniors rates of course.

Would we do it again? Oh yes, only we need to fill the whole train next time.

#### **DANCE TERMS CONTINUED:**

#### Natural Spin Turn

This figure is in two parts – begins with 1-2-3 of a natural turn, then finishes with a spin turn on the last three steps, facing diagonal to wall down LOD, right foot forward, left foot to side across LOD, close right foot to left foot (now backing LOD). Now, step left foot back down LOD and commence turning strongly to the right, step right foot forward down LOD still turning to the right, step left foot the side to finish facing diagonal to center down LOD. You should have completed ¾ of a full rotation. (started facing diag wall down LOD finished facing diag center down LOD).

#### Natural Fallaway

This figure, usually from the promenade position moves diagonally towards the wall down LOD, then down the LOD, then backs diagonally towards the center. From promenade position man step right foot (lady steps left foot) forward diagonally to the wall, turning to the right – step left foot to the side (lady steps right foot), still turning right step back right foot (Lady left foot) diagonally to the center down LOD.

#### New York

A Latin figure, danced either down or against LOD - man, step right foot (lady left foot) forward down LOD and check, right shoulder leading lady's left hand in mans right hand (in extended hold position) replace weight back to left foot, turning to the right, right foot to side against LOD facing wall (lady facing center and partner.

#### **Outside Check**

In natural hold, face diagonal to wall down LOD, step left foot forward and to wall on the outside of the lady (lady right foot back and towards the wall) in a contra body movement position

#### **Outside Partner**

Any step forward outside partner.

#### Partner Outside

Any step back with partner outside.

#### **Outward Turn**

A three-step turn that is away from your partner (outwards)

Is turning on the ball of one foot, whilst the other is in contra body movement position.

Taken in any direction, point the yoe of the foot to the floor without weight, no rise on the supporting foot.
